What is the Woodland Golf Club Scholarship Foundation?

The Woodland Golf Club Scholarship Foundation awards financial assistance to be applied toward educational or vocational tuition or postgraduate loan repayment to deserving past and present employees, their children, and members of the Auburndale community. Through these means, the Foundation demonstrates the Club's respect and appreciation for loyal service to its members, commitment to educational and vocational advancement, and its role as an integral part of the community of Auburndale.

When did the Scholarship Foundation Start? How successful has it been?

The Scholarship Foundation was formed in 2017 to help recipients meet the staggering costs of education and to show our support for their aspirations. Since then, the Woodland Golf Club Scholarship Foundation has provided 190 grants totaling \$345,000. Funding comes from the donations of members, businesses, and the community.

How much of my donation is used for grants?

100% of your donation goes to the Foundation in support of its mission. In addition, because the Foundation is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, your contribution is tax deductible.

How are grants determined?

An impartial committee considers each applicant's need, merit, and promise and makes grant recommendations to the Board of Directors based on information provided in the application and learned during an interview process.

Vocational and educational award recipients receive a check to offset tuition or fees at the institution they are currently attending. Grants are paid directly to the lender for post graduate loan assistance grant recipients.

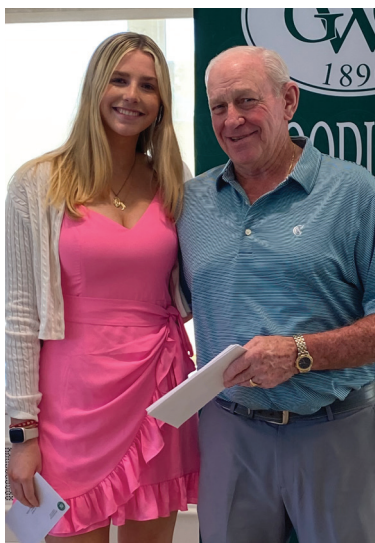
